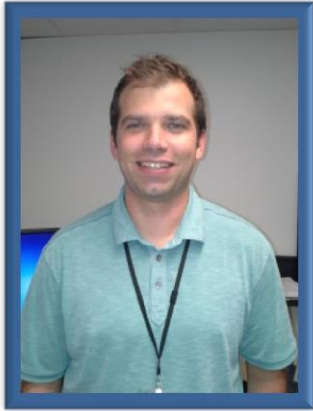


ISM – Columbia Basin 2018 – 2019 Leadership Team

Don Stewart – Membership Chair

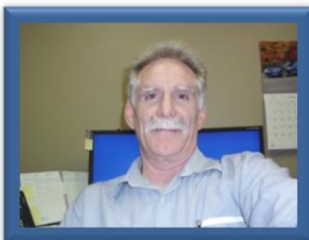
