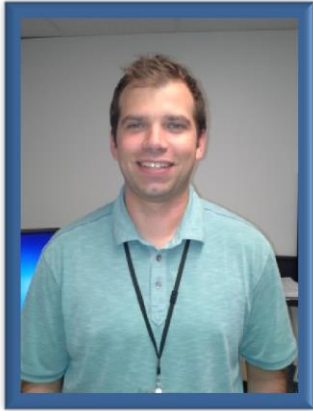


## ISM – Columbia Basin 2019 – 2020 Leadership Team
